Race Start Time: 8:30 am SHARP! **The starting line will be shut down at 8:45 am**

Please wear your race bib pinned to the **FRONT** of your shirt/jacket.

South Flores St. will close down at 7:00 am, in front of The Commander's House, in preparation for the race to start. All other streets will close down at 8:15 am and you will not be allowed on streets that include the race route. There is a lot of construction on the streets surrounding the venue. Please be aware that there may be delays due to that construction and leave home early to get there on time! Street closures on South Santa Rosa and West Nueva will especially affect being able to get to the Bexar County Parking Garage, which is a very convenient parking location. If you are approaching from I35, take the Frio St. exit, go north to Buena Vista/Dolorosa (that would be a right), then go south on S. Flores (that would also be a right turn). Get there early!

Please note not to park on streets that are included in the race route or on the interior of the route unless you are planning on staying until the end of the event. **This especially pertains to streets in the King William District as those streets will be the last to open due to being the end of the route. (South Alamo, East Sheridan, Madison St., King William St., Beauregard St., Turner St. and Washington St.)**

RIDE SHARE DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

For those using a ride share service, please use the H-E-B Parking Garage at 407 Dwyer Ave. as your designated drop-off and pick-up location. From there, you can walk across the Skybridge to the Commander's House.

Awards:

The Award Ceremony will be at 9:45 am and will be based on the results at 9:40. If something changes with those awards, we will contact you via email after the race. Overall winners will be based on gun time and the age group awards will be based on chip timing.

Strollers are allowed, but no skateboards, scooters or bikes.

If you are pushing a stroller, or bringing along your pup, please stay to the back of the pack at the start of the race.

We are expecting around 7,000+ runners this year, please remember that the starting line will **close at 8:45 am**, If you get there late, you'll need to stay on the sidewalks until you catch up with the "pack."

There will be 2 water stations along the route: S. Presa & Cesar Chavez and the corner of Washington & Arsenal

There isn't a bag check at this event. Please plan on being able to carry what you have with you during the race.
